The road is major route used by emergency vehicles and has seen a significant increase in heavy vehicles due to two new Cotton Gins now operating in the area. There are constraints on vehicle movements due to the inadequate pavement strength and width.

The construction of the new bridge over the Murrumbidgee River at Carrathool has made Murrumbidgee River Road a Sturt Highway by-pass in the event of a closure of the highway.
