Freight Hub at WR Connect (open access – operated by LINX). Extensive program of investment initiatives to expand intermodal capacity and provide a sustainable alternative to existing intermodals in the region.

PROJECT BRIEF

The WRConnect Program is a series of projects to:

- establish a new intermodal at Wumbulgal, situated between Griffith & Leeton, the two hubs of the Western Riverina agribusiness and manufacturing boom
- enable the creation of a new agribusiness and logistics precinct at Wumbulgal
- install passing loops at Wumbulgal, so as to avoid loading directly onto the line, improving freight efficiency
- provide an alternative intermodal site to the present Griffith CBD freight terminal, which is unsustainable given Griffith's growing population, its proximity to the main street of Griffith and hospital and associated safety and amenity risks.



Purpose

To: improve freight efficiency; shift freight from road onto rail; increase productivity; and enhance community safety & amenity by removing freight movements from Griffith CBD.

Rationale for Investment

The Western Riverina has insufficient intermodal capacity to accommodate the potential of Inland Rail to see more freight volumes moved to market via rail and improve the efficiency of the logistics chain.

In addition, one of the region's existing intermodals, in the Griffith CBD, is unsustainable, given impacts on the city's growing population and its adjacency to the main street, hospital and community facilities & amenities.

Benefits

- Improve freight efficiency
- Shift freight from road onto rail, to the benefit of Inland Rail's commercial value proposition and the overall freight network
- Increase productivity from a more efficient logistics
- Agglomeration and economic development benefits from creating the Wumbulgal Agribusiness, manufacturing & logistics precinct
- Enhance community safety & amenity by removing freight movements from Griffith CBD.
